

Fire Extinguisher Training

Portable fire extinguishers are designed for small, incipient, controllable fires. For a fire extinguisher to be effective, the following conditions must be met:

- the extinguisher must be right for the type of fire;
- it must be located where it can be easily reached;
- it must be in good working order;
- the fire must be discovered while it is still small;
- the person using the extinguisher must be trained in its use.

Trained Employees will have greater confidence in their capabilities to cope with fire emergencies.

Trained Employees use portable fire extinguishers with 25% greater effectiveness than untrained employees.

Property losses and Production downtime through fire can be appreciably reduced or eliminated.
