Lockout - Tagout standards establish the employer's responsibility to protect employees in the workplace from hazardous energy sources on machinery and equipment when service and maintenance is being performed. This is generally done by affixing the appropriate lockout or tagout devices to energy-isolating devices and by de-energizing machinery and equipment.
